

How to Access MyIMR & Your DD Form 2992

MyIMR (Individual Medical Readiness) shows your current medical readiness status. Your **DD Form 2992** (Medical Recommendation for Flying or Special Operational Duty) is the form that proves you are cleared — you may be asked for it at the flight line. Know how to pull it before you need it.

THREE STEPS

1. **Log in with your CAC:** asimsimr.health.mil/imr/MyImr.aspx
2. **Check your IMR status.** Any item in **YELLOW** or **RED** is due or overdue and needs action. **PINK** items are optional.
 - *Cadets: ignore the PHA column — your PHA is handled differently.*
3. **View, save, and print your DD Form 2992:**
 - Click the “**Grounding Mgmt**” tab.
 - Click “**Select**” next to the current entry — your DD Form 2992 opens.
 - **Sign and Save or print the form** — don’t wait until someone asks for it.
